## Residential Detached Garages



- Must be subordinate to and located on the same lot as the principal building and used in conjunction with the principal use.
- Shall not be constructed or placed on any site prior to the construction of the principal building. (There cannot be only a garage on a residential lot, a house must be there first.)
- It is the landowners responsibility to have a current legal property survey done in order to determine where property lines are.


## Number of Detached Garages

- In the R1, R2 and RMH Districts, only one (1) detached garage not exceeding 100 m 2 (1,075 ft2) is allowed.
- In the R3 District, detached garages are NOT allowed.
- In the R3A and R3B Districts, only one (1) detached garage not exceeding $185.8 \mathrm{~m} 2(2,000 \mathrm{ft} 2)$ is allowed.


## Maximum Height

- Maximum Height: NOT to exceed the height of the principal building and in no case more than 5 meters (16 feet).


## Location and Set Backs From Property Lines

1. Detached garages shall NOT be located in any front yard.
2. No main door of a garage which faces a road shall be within 6 meters ( 20 feet) of the front property line faced by the door.
3. Rear Yard
a. Minimum distance of .6 meters ( 2 feet) , except where the main door faces the rear site line, the minimum distance shall be 1.2 meters (4 feet)
b. The detached garage shall not occupy more than forty percent $(40 \%)$ of the rear yard.
4. Side Yard
a. Minimum of .6 meters ( 2 feet) where the detached garage will be 1.8 meters ( 6 feet) behind the rear wall of the principal building; otherwise 1.2 meters ( 4 feet).
b. No main door of a garage which faces a road shall be within 3 meters ( 10 feet) of the side property line faced by the door. (Corner Lots)
